



THE GAME WHERE YOU MIGHT GO TOO FAR!

GAMEPLAY

The game is played over **5 rounds**.

OBJECT

You have 2 minutes to find an answer for each category, all starting with the letter on the die!



SETUP

Hand out **pens** and a **board** to all the players, which they will use to write their answers down.

1 • START OF A ROUND

At the beginning of each round, the **round** master:

- Gives all players a card with the same number which they place face down without looking at it;
- Rolls the **die** and announces the letter to everyone;
- Turns over the sand timer.

The player with the smallest earlobes is the first **round master**. In the next round, the person to their left takes over, and so on.

2 • «INSPIRATION» PHASE


Once the timer is turned over, all players, including the round master, turn over their card. They then have 2 minutes to think of an answer beginning with the letter on the die for each of the 8 categories on their card and write them down on their board.

IMPORTANT

It is the round master's responsibility to announce when the time is up!

EXAMPLE:Here is Roxy's card 2 minutes later!





3 • «NEGOTIATION» PHASE

 When time is up, the players can no longer write on their boards, and it's time to negotiate!

You'll need to **argue and justify** your answers if the other players don't accept them right away!

- The players take turns (starting with the round master) to give their answer for category 1. If anyone challenges another player's answer, that answer is put to the vote, to decide whether it is accepted or not!
- Once all the answers for category 1 have been accepted or rejected, move on to category 2 of the card, and so on!

IMPORTANT

It's a majority decision, but the answer is also accepted if there is a tie. You can't vote for your own answers!

4 • SCORING

Keep a running tally of your score:

- Answer accepted AND unique (2 POINTS): you were the only one to come up with this answer, and the other players accepted it!
- Answer accepted, but not unique (1 POINT): although the answer is accepted, you weren't the only one to suggest it for this category.
- Answer not accepted (O POINTS): bad luck, the players voted and your answer was not accepted...

When all 8 categories have been scored, the player with the most points wins the round and ticks the 'round(s) won' box (on their board).

Roxy scored 11 points and won the first round!

5 • HOW TO WIN

At the end of the 5 rounds, the player with the most rounds wins the game!

IMPORTANT

Ties

- **Tied round**: the tied players all win the round.
- Tie at the end of the game: there is a final play-off round to decide between players who are tied after 5 rounds. The other players do not take part in the play-off, but they are the only ones who are able to vote on whether to accept the finalists' answers.

In the rare event that the finalists have the same number of points in the play-off, the other players vote for the winner, based on who they think was the most creative.

A LITTLE WORD FROM THE CREATORS

TO SAVE A FEW ARGUMENTS...

Let's take the : «_____ helps to get over a break-up» category as an example. The die shows the letter 'T'.

 Adjectives, articles, numbers, pronouns, and prepositions are not allowed.

Example with an **adjective**: Terrrible movies **X**Example with an **article**: The movies **X**Example with a **number**: Ten movies **X**Example with a **pronoun**: Their movies **X**Example with a **preposition**: To the movies **X**

• However, you CAN suggest a single word, a group of words or a sentence.

- Brand names and proper names in general are allowed.
- People's first or last names can be accepted.
- An answer can only be used once per player per round.

... INCLUDING WHEN IT COMES TO JUDGING!

What criteria should be used to decide if a response should be accepted or not?

Exercise good judgment (and not bad faith!). In other words, let common sense prevail. Ask yourself if the answer fits the category. Will the other players be able to convince you?

Looking after your game:

Wiping the boards with a damp cloth at the end of the game (and not at the start of the next!), will keep them in good condition for many more games in the future!
